European Innovation Partnership for agricultural productivity and sustainability (EIP-AGRI)

- Launched by the Commission Communication in February 2012
- Aim: to stimulate innovation and improve the exchange of knowledge
- Approach: Closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:
 - using the interactive innovation model (EIP operational groups)
 - linking actors via the EU CAP Network (broad range of networking activities and events)

EIP operational groups

- EIP operational groups (OGs) form part of the EIP-AGRI:
 - focusing on farmers' or foresters' needs and tackling the interactions across the supply chain where useful
 - bringing together partners with complementary knowledge
 - co-deciding and co-creating all along the project
- OGs may act at transnational level, may be based on traditional practices in a new geographical/environmental context
- OGs disseminate summaries of plans and results of their projects, also through the national and European CAP networks

EIP OGs in the CAP 2023-2027

- MSs' obligation to provide innovation support for OGs grassroots ideas, needs
- CAP networks: will connect existing OGs to collaborate
- 80% EU-cofinancing instead of 43%
- 100% support (aid intensity) for non-productive investments for OGs
- Advance payments up to 50% for OGs possible
- State Aid derogation below € 500.000 Euro per project



EIP OGs: achievements and plans

2014-2022

- ✓ 26 Member States, 98 RDPs implementing EIP OGs' "innovative projects"
- √ 3 200 OGs planned; around 2700 OGs running or finished (1 billion EUR)
- ✓ Over 200 multi-actor projects under Horizon 2020
- ✓ A growing and thriving network


2023-2027

- ✓ 25 Member States implementing EIP OGs "innovative projects"
- ✓ Over 6 600 OGs' projects planned
- ✓ EUR 9 billion for multi-actor projects under Horizon Europe Cluster 6 "Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment"
- ✓ Strengthening of Innovation & Knowledge Exchange I EIP-AGRI strand of EU CAP Network


The concept AKIS: how people and organisations connect to promote mutual learning, to generate, share, and use agriculture related knowledge/information

AKIS in the CAP 2023-2027

- The aim: to create a <u>regional/national knowledge and innovation</u>
 system by organising and enhancing knowledge flows between the AKIS actors as well as strengthening <u>links between research and practice</u>
- CAP Strategic Plans 2023-2027 (main elements in relation to AKIS):
 - The organisational set-up of AKIS: systemic approach
 - How advisors, researchers and national CAP networks will work together
 - Integration of all advisors in AKIS
 - Innovation support services



- Contribute to the information of the public and potential beneficiaries on the CAP and funding opportunities




- Contribute to monitoring and evaluation capacity and activities;


